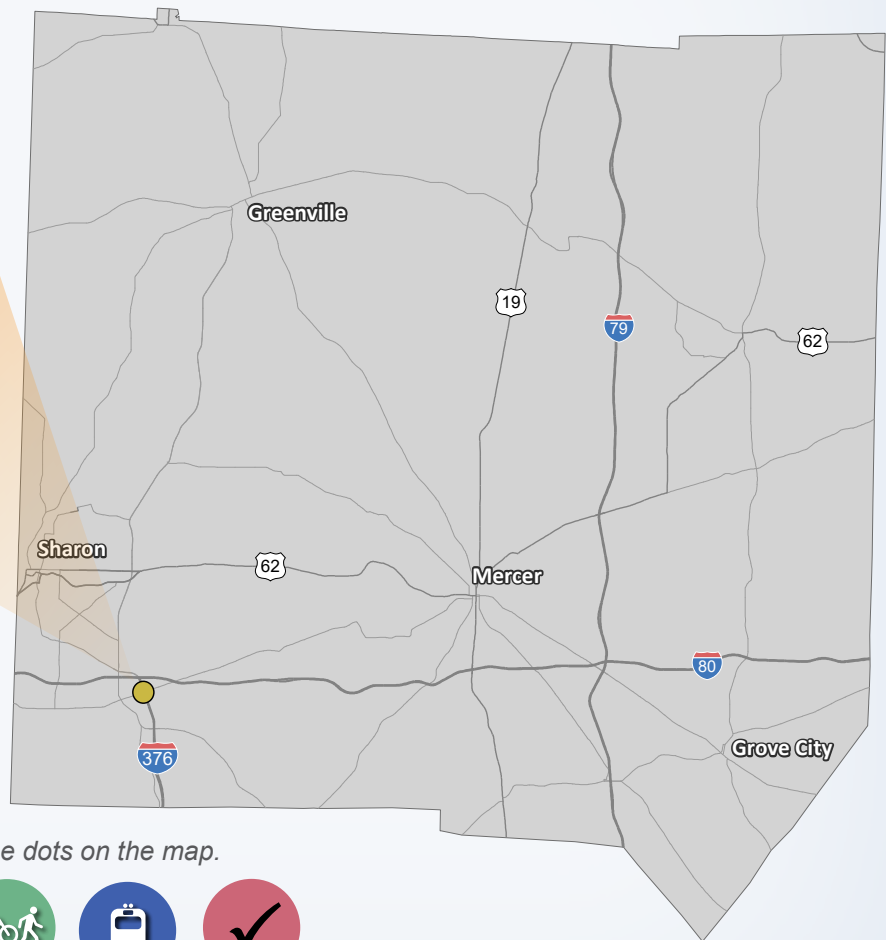

Statewide, survey participants mapped over **3,500** transportation concerns.

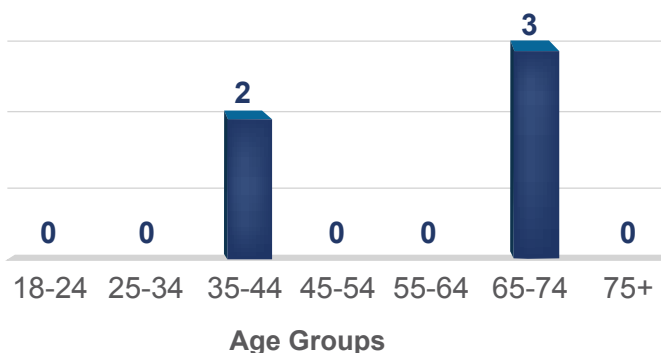
About the Survey Participants in Your Region
